The session was full of conversation, laughter and creativity, and residents thoroughly enjoyed spending time together while helping prepare another exciting addition to our outdoor space.



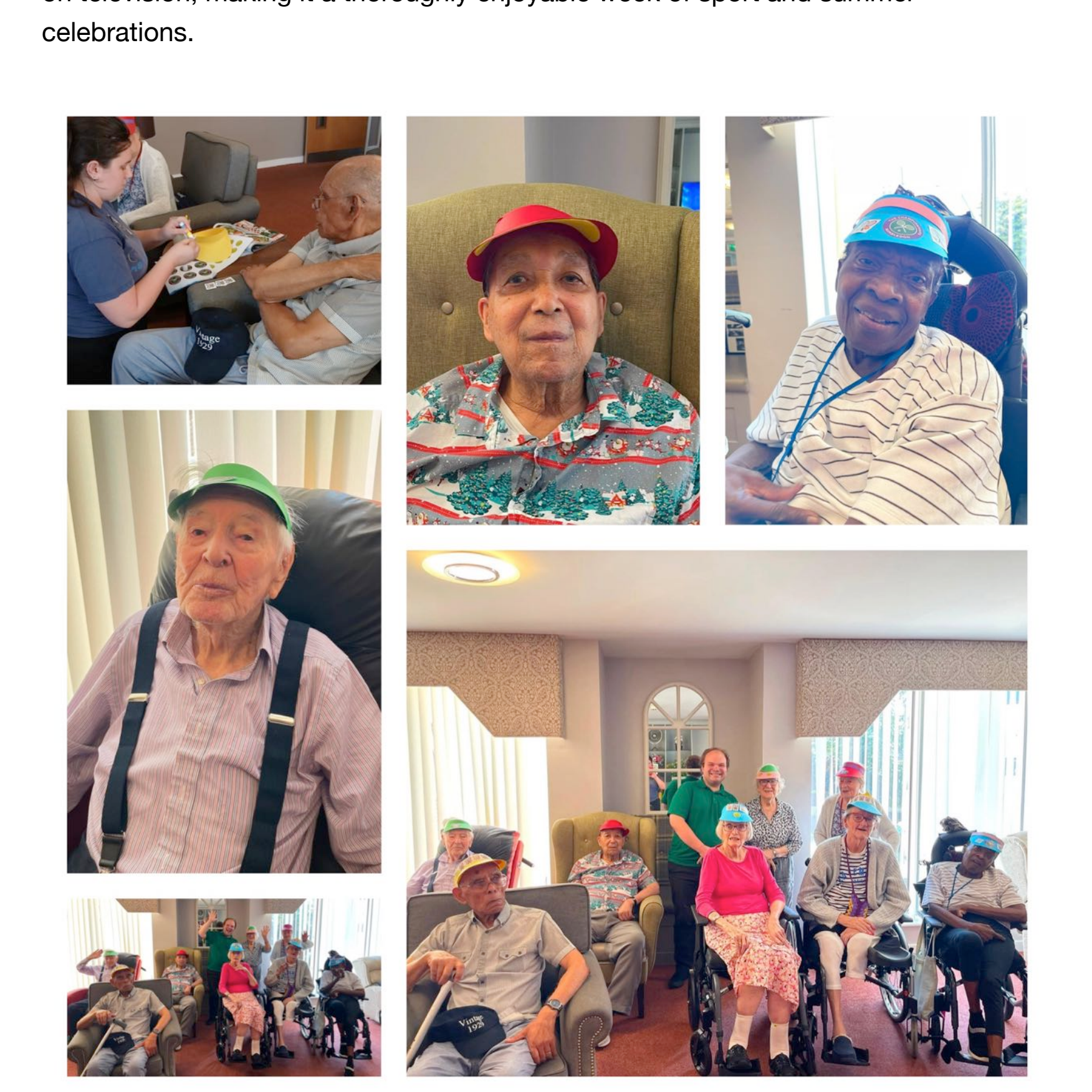
Wimbledon Week

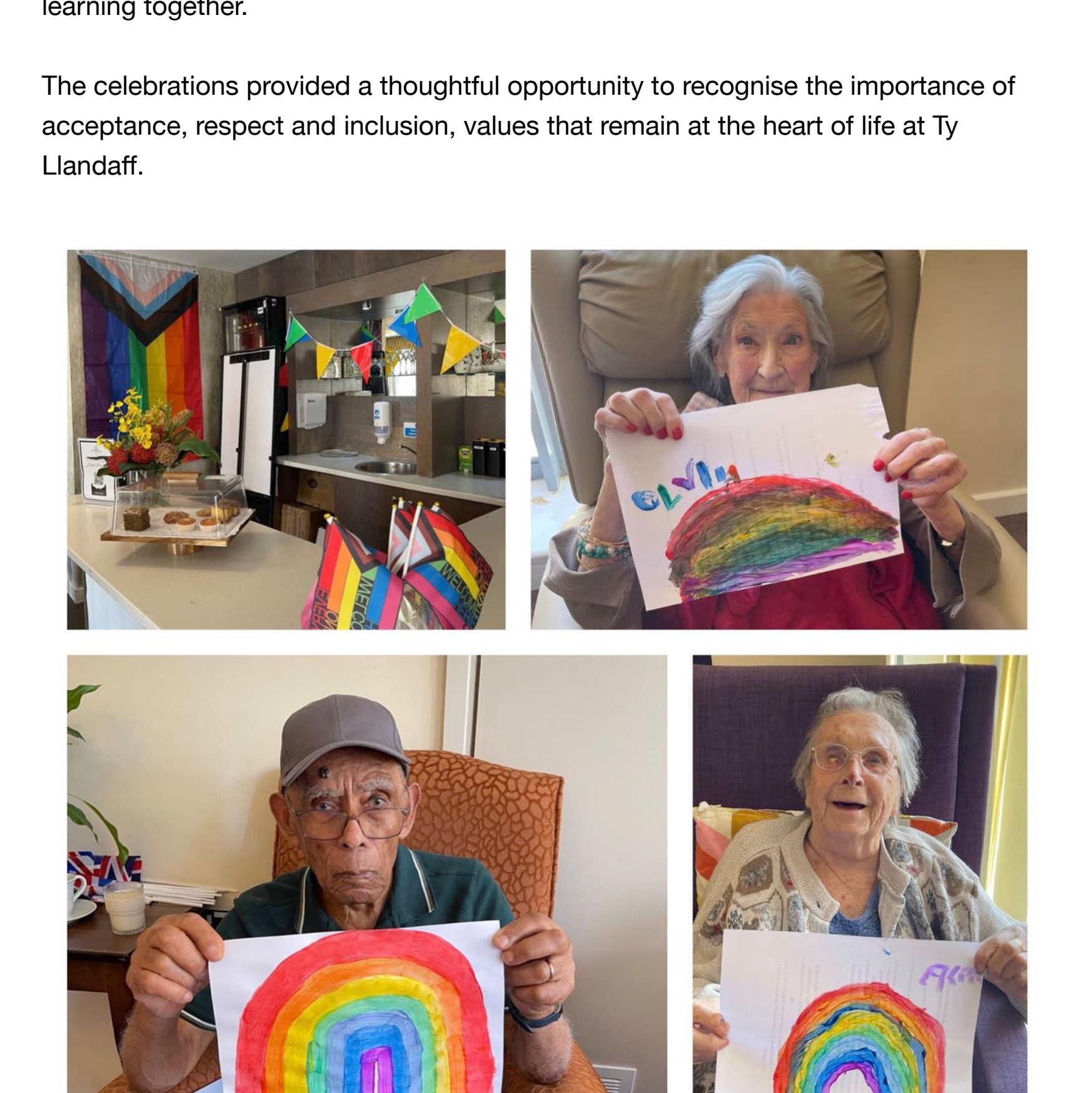


Celebrating Pride Month

The celebrations provided a thoughtful opportunity to recognise the importance of acceptance, respect and inclusion, values that remain at the heart of life at Ty Llandaff.

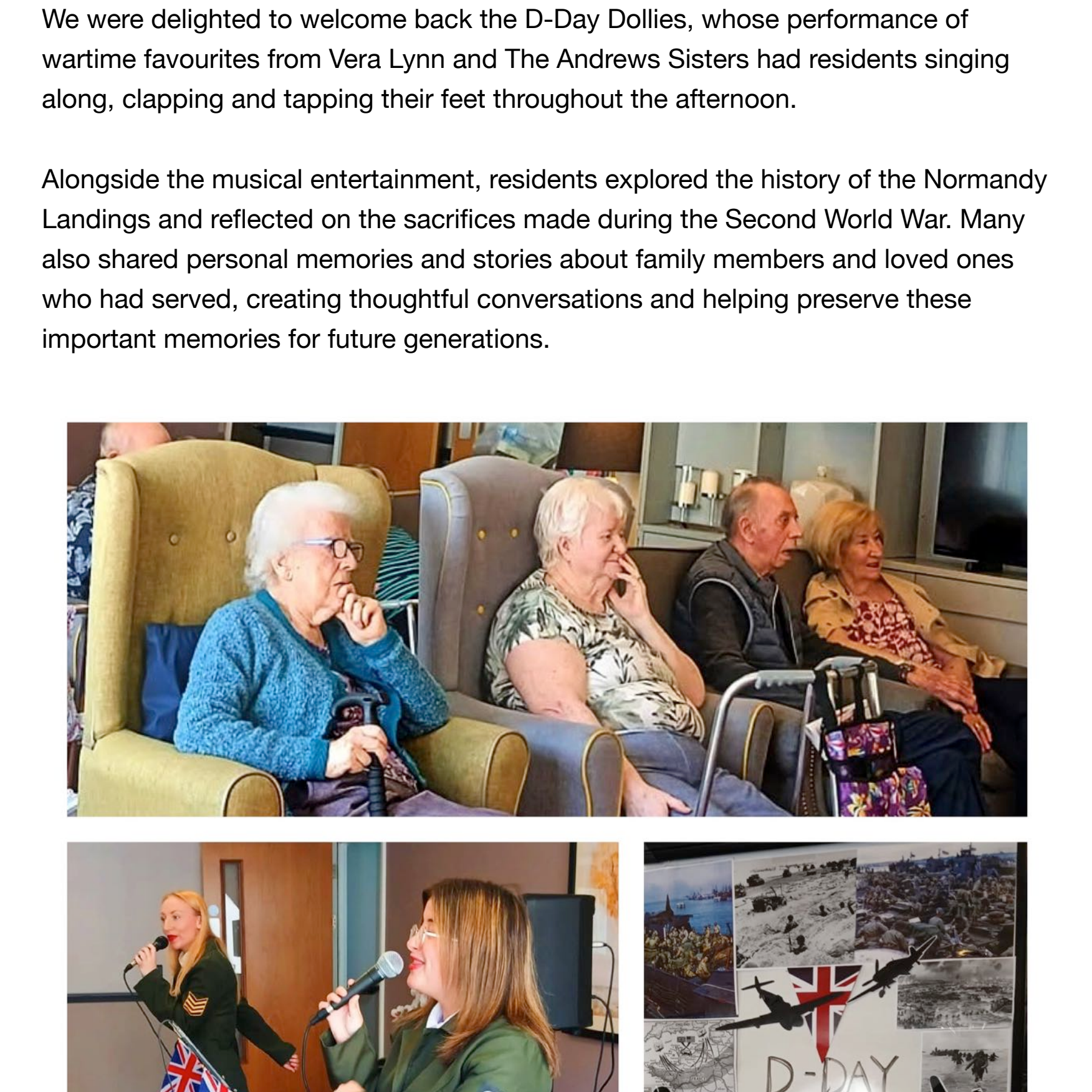


Remembering D-Day

A heartfelt thank you goes to every member of our care team for their continued commitment and hard work.



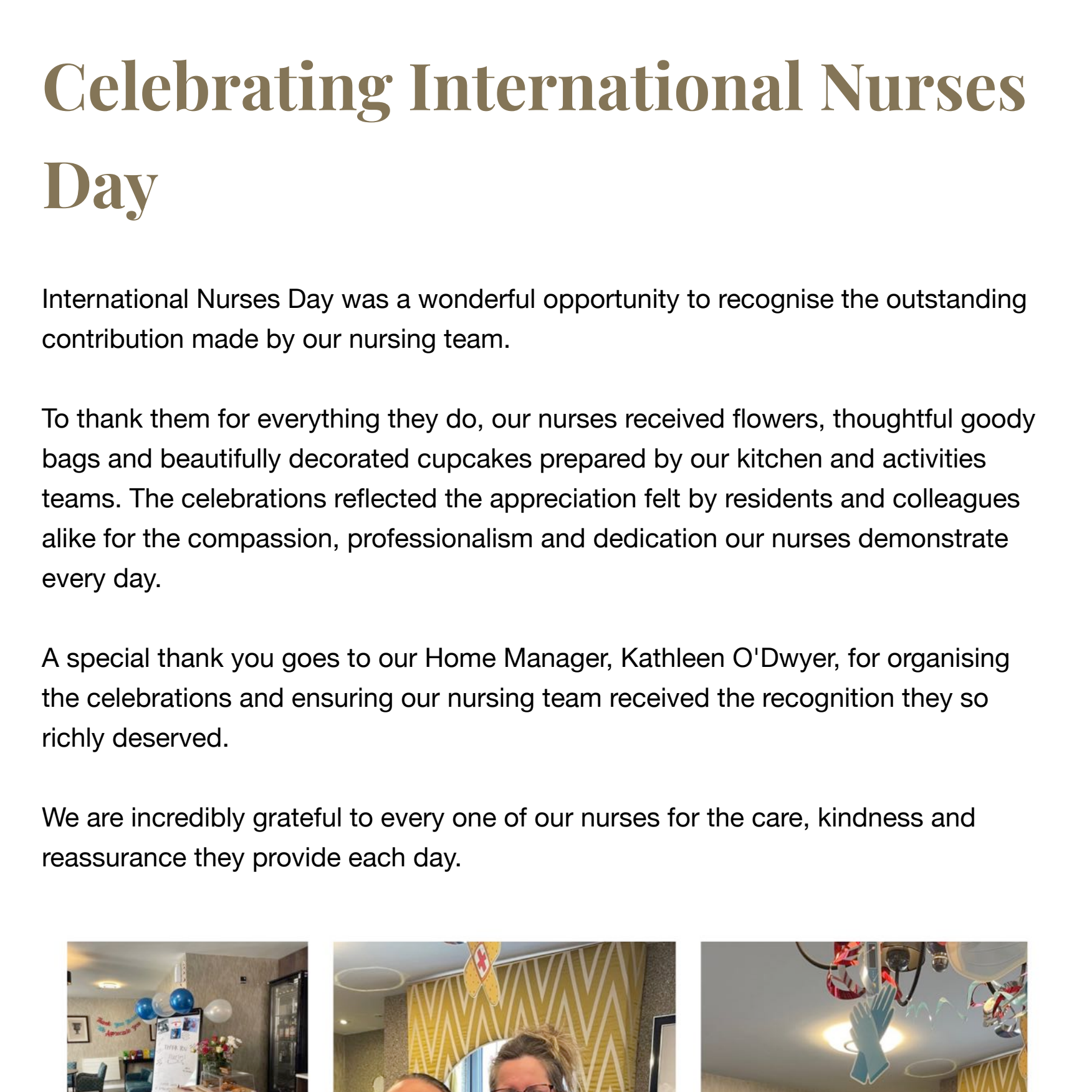
Celebrating International Nurses Day
